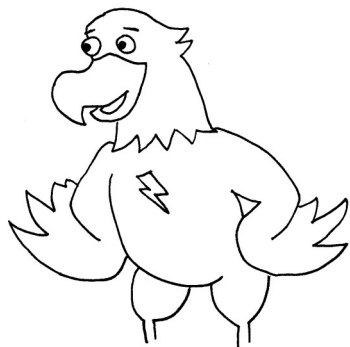


Hey there! I'm the Mahwah Thunderbird, here to guide you on your tour of Mahwah.

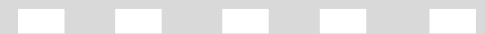
