

TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH

ORDINANCE NO. 1851

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XV ENTITLED "STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND SANITATION", SUB-CHAPTER 8 ENTITLED "TEMPORARY NON-COMMERCIAL SIGNS WITHIN TOWNSHIP RIGHT-OF-WAYS".

WHEREAS, the Township of Mahwah enacted Chapter 15-8 governing the erection of temporary non-commercial signs within Township right-of-ways pursuant to Ordinance No. 2016-1789; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that the written notification for removal of signs in violation of the ordinance requires amending.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 15-8 "Temporary non-commercial signs within Township right-of-ways is hereby amended and supplemented by revising Section 15-8.4a5, Removal of Signs, in its entirety as follows:

15-8.4 Conditions for Approval by Council

a....

5. Removal of Signs. Any sign erected in violation of this section shall be removed within two (2) days after receipt of written notification from the Zoning Officer of the violation to the organization that erected or applied the sign. If a sign is not removed after notice, a fine may be assessed in accordance with subsection 15-8.5 hereof. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, the Township reserves the right to remove any temporary non-commercial sign that has been erected within the public right-of-way in violation of this section in which case, the cost incurred by the Township for the removal of the illegal temporary sign shall be paid by the organization or political

campaign committee named on the non-commercial sign as being responsible for the erection or funding for the sign.

Section 2. The remaining provisions of Chapter 15-8, "Temporary Non-commercial Signs within Township Right-of-ways" are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and final passage according to law.


