

TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH
ORDINANCE #1755

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER II ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" SECTION 16 "REGULATIONS AND MEMBERSHIP OF POLICE DEPARTMENT" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER II SECTION 16.18 ENTITLED "OFF-DUTY AND OUTSIDE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM", SUBSECTION E.

WHEREAS, the Township of Mahwah desires to amend and supplement the provisions of Chapter II, Section 16.18 of the Mahwah Revised General Ordinances to increase the fees charged in the Off-duty and Outside Employment Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah has determined that this increase would be in the best interest of the citizens of the Township of Mahwah.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah as follows:

Section 1. Chapter II "Administration", Section 16 "Regulation and Membership of Police Department", Subsection 16.18, entitled "Off-duty and Outside Employment Program", Subsection E of the Mahwah Revised General Ordinances shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

2-16.18 Off-duty and Outside Employment Program

- A. No change
- B. No change
- C. No change
- D. No change

E. The initial deposit required for each private person shall be estimated by the higher of

- (a) the time and a half rate of a top step patrol officer's base pay according to the Township's collective bargaining agreement. (2014 current rate is \$92.16) or
- (b) the rate being paid to police officers from adjoining municipalities serving on the same detail with Mahwah Police Officers.

In addition, there will be a 20 percent (20%) Administration fee charged per hour to cover the costs of scheduling, billing, vehicle maintenance, etc.

F. No change

Section 2. All other definitions, parts, portions and provisions of Chapter II, "Administration", Section 16.18, "Off-duty and Outside Employment Program" which are not inconsistent herewith, are ratified and confirmed. In the event of any such inconsistencies, the terms and provision of this Ordinance shall govern.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
