AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NOS. 1684,  
1686 AND 1687 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH,  
ADOPTED MARCH 31, 2011 WHICH PERMITTED AN  
OVERLAY ZONE ON THE SHERATON CROSSROADS  
PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah has determined that it is  
in the interest of the public to rescind certain ordinances that the Township adopted on March 31,  
2011; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council is desirous of repealing Township Ordinances 1684,  
1686 and 1687 to reflect this interest;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**

The Township Council of the Township of Mahwah  
hereby repeals Township Ordinances 1684, 1686 and  
1687 effective as provided by law

All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the provisions of this  
ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of any inconsistencies.

The provisions of this ordinance is severable. If any part of the ordinance is declared to be  
unconstitutional or invalid by any court, the remaining parts of the ordinance will remain in full force  
and effect.


The amended ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in
