

**Minutes of the  
April 12, 2011  
Meeting  
Township of Mahwah  
Community Cable TV  
Committee**

Meeting was called to order at 7:35 P.M.

- **Guest** - Mayor John DaPuzzo attended the meeting to thank the members of the MCN for their service to the community and to assure the committee that he was only a phone call away if the committee ever needed his assistance. Additionally, the mayor requested any names that the committee wished to submit to him in order to fill the vacancy that now exists on the MCN committee.
