

# Quackenbush Farm



The big red barn in Winter's Park looks like it should be on a farm rather than in a park. As a matter of fact, this barn, the Quackenbush Barn, was originally part of the Way family farm. This farm was on Sparrowbush Road in the Masonicus section of Mahwah. It was built around 1850. It originally had two levels. The first level was home to the farm animals, while farm equipment was kept on the second level. In 1868, it was sold to Cornelius A. Quackenbush. It remained in the Quackenbush family until 1942. In 1998, Mahwah's Historic Preservation Commission relocated the barn to its current location. Recently, it was repainted by a local Boy Scout troop.
