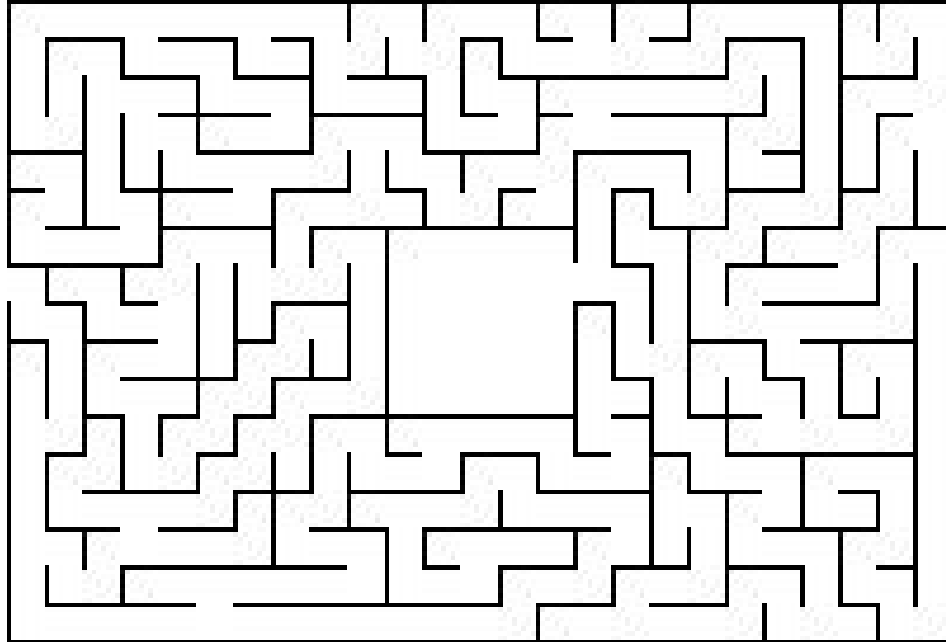


Ackerman House

Fardale was not always made up of the neighborhoods that it is today. In fact, Fardale was made up of farms. Garrett G. Ackerman owned one of these farms. The Ackermans were Dutch settlers who came to America in the 1700s. Garrett Ackerman lived in the Ackerman house. Nearby, on Ackerman Pond, he owned a farm and gristmill. He lived in the home until he died in 1870 after falling off of his horse drawn wagon. His brother, John Ackerman, lived there until 1913. The house is the colonial revival style. It had rooms added to it throughout the years. In 2006, the county rebuilt the wall surrounding it.
